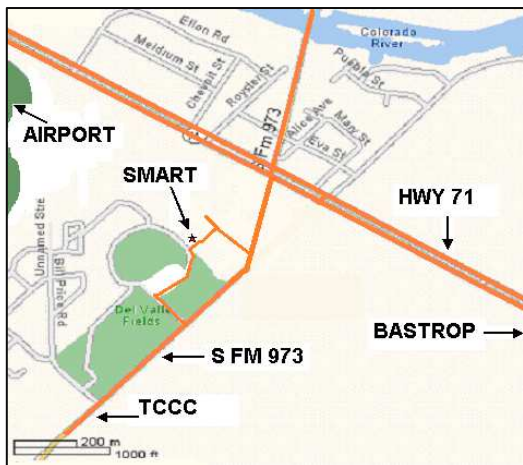

SMART PROGRAM MISSION

Using a team approach, the SMART Treatment Program promotes substance use recovery by educating, inspiring and empowering probationers and their families toward positive change and pro-social behavior leading to a better and safer community.

RECOVERY GOALS

- ★ Reduce recidivism.
- ★ Reduce the cost of alcohol and other drug abuse to the community and assist in providing safer communities.
- ★ Provide offenders with the skills necessary to begin recovery and maintain an alcohol and drug-free lifestyle.
- ★ Create a cognitive shift that promotes pro-social attitudes, beliefs and behavior.
- ★ Provide offenders with the skills necessary to become gainfully employed.
- ★ Assist families in understanding and supporting offenders in recovery.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

SMART is a community corrections-based substance abuse treatment and offender rehabilitation program for adult males and females. Residential and Continuing Care services are offered. It is a specialized treatment program designed to meet the needs of offenders.

It is operated by Travis County Adult Probation Department and funded by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Community Justice Assistance Division.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Eligible for Admission

- ★ There must be a court order for participation.
- ★ High and medium risk offenders can be accepted.
- ★ Offenders must have an advanced alcohol or other substance abuse problem, regardless of whether there is any previous history of treatment.
- ★ Intellectual functioning must be at a level where the offender is able to comprehend and participate in program activities.
- ★ Offenders who are on probation for or have a history of family violence will be eligible on a case-by-case basis.
- ★ Offenders with co-occurring disorders or have other substantial mental health issues are acceptable if stabilized on non-narcotic medication, and psychiatric is not the primary need.
- ★ Offenders must not have serious medical or physical problems that would require ongoing medical treatment (i.e. physical therapy) off-site that would limit their ability to participate in program activities.

Ineligible for Admission

- ★ Offenders who have medical, physical and/or psychiatric issues who are not stabilized on non-narcotic medications.
- ★ Offenders whose current probated offense is a Title V offense, with the exception of family violence.
- ★ Offenders who have exhibited a propensity for violence/assaultive behavior.
- ★ Offenders diagnosed with a severe level of psychopathy.
- ★ Offenders who are pregnant.

Please note that due to confidentiality laws information regarding a client will not be released unless the client has signed a release for disclosure of such information.

RESIDENTIAL & CONTINUING CARE SERVICES

Treatment levels are provided in the Residential phase which consists of:

- ★ No treatment fee
- ★ 13 Week (91 Days) and 20 Week Track Residential Programs
- ★ Cognitive Group Counseling / Education Services
- ★ Family Program
- ★ On-site Recovery Support Meetings
- ★ Voluntary Religious Services
- ★ Experiential Outings
- ★ Voluntary GED/HSE Program
- ★ Collaboration with Goodwill Job Source Program
- ★ Exterior Movements Prior to Discharge for Re-integration Purposes
- ★ Specialized Groups to meet individualized needs (i.e. parenting, relapse prevention, etc.)
- ★ Specialized Recovery Track for individuals with co-occurring disorders

After completion of the Residential phase, clients are placed in the Continuing Care phase of the program which consists of:

- ★ Weekly, 2 or 3 Hour Group sessions for a minimum of 6 Months
- ★ Individual Sessions Monthly with Counselor and Probation Officer
- ★ Participation in a Re-Entry Problem-Solving Court
- ★ Participation in Recovery Activities
- ★ Referral to Community Resources
